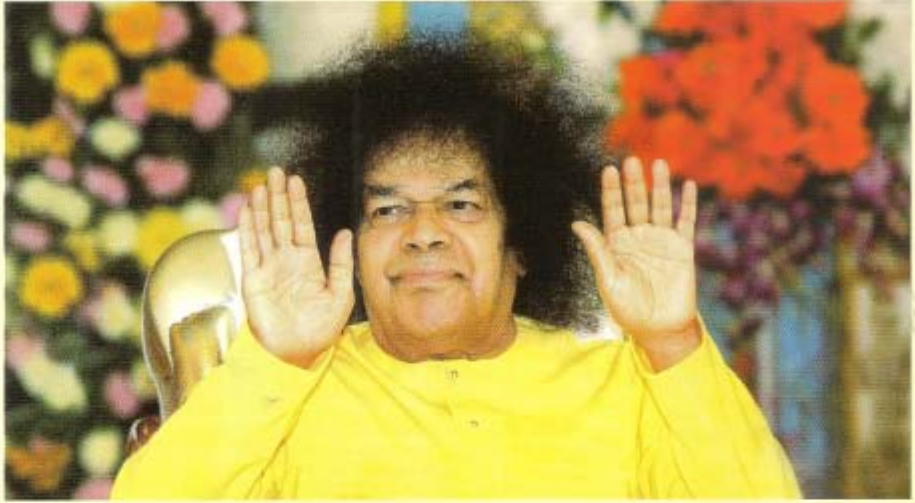

The Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Medicare Project is a manifestation of the Divine Love and Grace of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba for the people of Maharashtra. The project was officially launched with Bhagawan's blessings on the 13th of June, 2008, keeping in mind that basic health care should be available to all irrespective of caste and creed.

Professionals in the medical and social welfare fields have stressed that if man has to enjoy better health than utmost importance should be accorded to primary health care. The Mobile Medicare Project seeks to make health care available to the weaker sections of society, at their doorstep, totally free of cost.

The mobile dispensaries are viable alternatives to the setting up of hospitals and clinics and to achieve a wider coverage of the population particularly in the rural areas at a very low cost.

Currently, 16 mobile dispensaries are functioning and very shortly 3 more vans are being put on the road.

With Bhagawan's Grace we have been able to reach out to over four lakh patients and will gradually cover all the villages adopted under the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme.

The experiences of Bhagawan's Omnipresence with several miraculous cures taking place are constantly inspiring and motivating us. We pray to Bhagawan for His Grace & Blessings so that we continue to render more meaningful service to suffering humanity as a part of His Divine Mission.

Features of The Project & Facilities To Be Provided

- Acquisition of several mobile dispensaries fully equipped with necessary facilities available at a General Practitioner's Clinic.
- Envisages the provision of free medical treatment and medicines in a professional manner.
- Manned by professionals – supported by our seva dal and volunteers.
- Visiting fixed centres, orphanages, destitute homes, old folks homes etc., as per a fixed schedule. Conducting general diagnosis and prescribing suitable treatments.
- Conducting blood donation camps, Mother & Child care Camps, Eye camps, Bone Density Checkup Camps, Dental Camps, Diabetes Checkup etc.
- Selective use of body and mind medicare by Yoga Therapy, Meditational Therapy, Homeopathic Treatment, Ayurved Treatment i.e. provision of alternative medicines and therapies.
- Provision of Pathological tests whenever possible.
- Directing advanced cases to Sri Sathya Sai affiliated hospitals & Government Hospitals.
- Vaccination Camps jointly with other NGO / Governmental Health Schemes etc in rural areas particularly. Infectious diseases continue to be the biggest killer, a scenario unchanged since independence according to estimates available.

- Coordinating with local leaders, Village Panchayats etc for a proper health plan.
- Provision of Nutrition, hygiene and safe drinking water guidance thus promoting a healthy life style i.e advising on preventive care and change of lifestyle. Mention may be made of a recent WHO report that states that one in every three malnourished children are from India, and about 50% of all childhood deaths in India are attributed to malnutrition. About 10% of the 27 million infants born do not survive for more than 5 years.
- To harness and channelise effectively resources of the organization to bring about a world movement with the support of locals on the basis of local time management scheme.

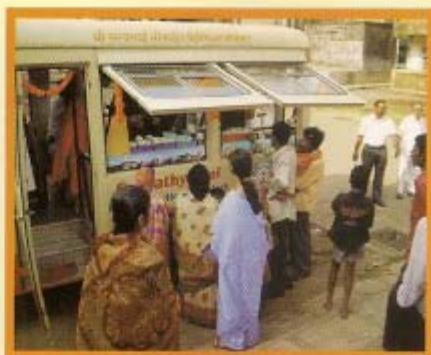

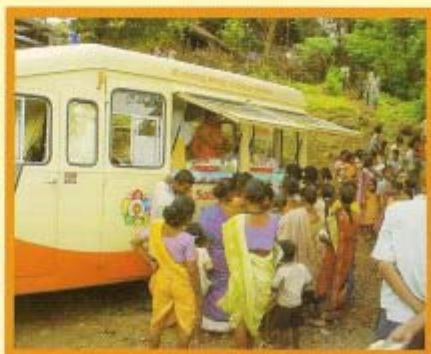

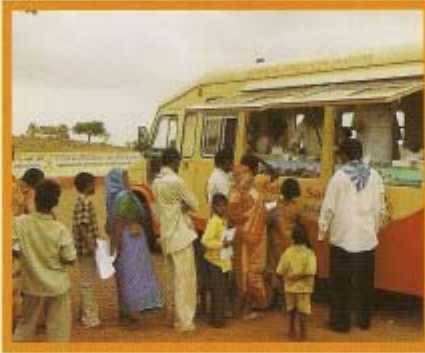
